Powder coat over galvanised steel may cause imperfections in paint - several products from Draffin's outdoor furniture range are hot dip galvanised for maximum corrosion protection. Whilst we have stringent powder coating procedures in place, the non-uniform nature of galvanising can make it difficult to control the quality of the powder coated surface. Gassing may occur, resulting in small dots or roughness on the painted surface. This does not affect the longevity of the protective coating and is generally deemed as an acceptable compromise in order to achieve the protective properties of galvanising. Draffin does not accept liability for any imperfections. Please note colours above are not true representations and slight shade variations can occur.

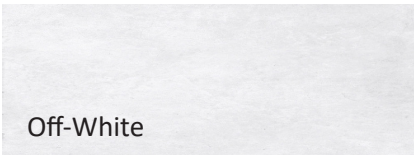
